Features

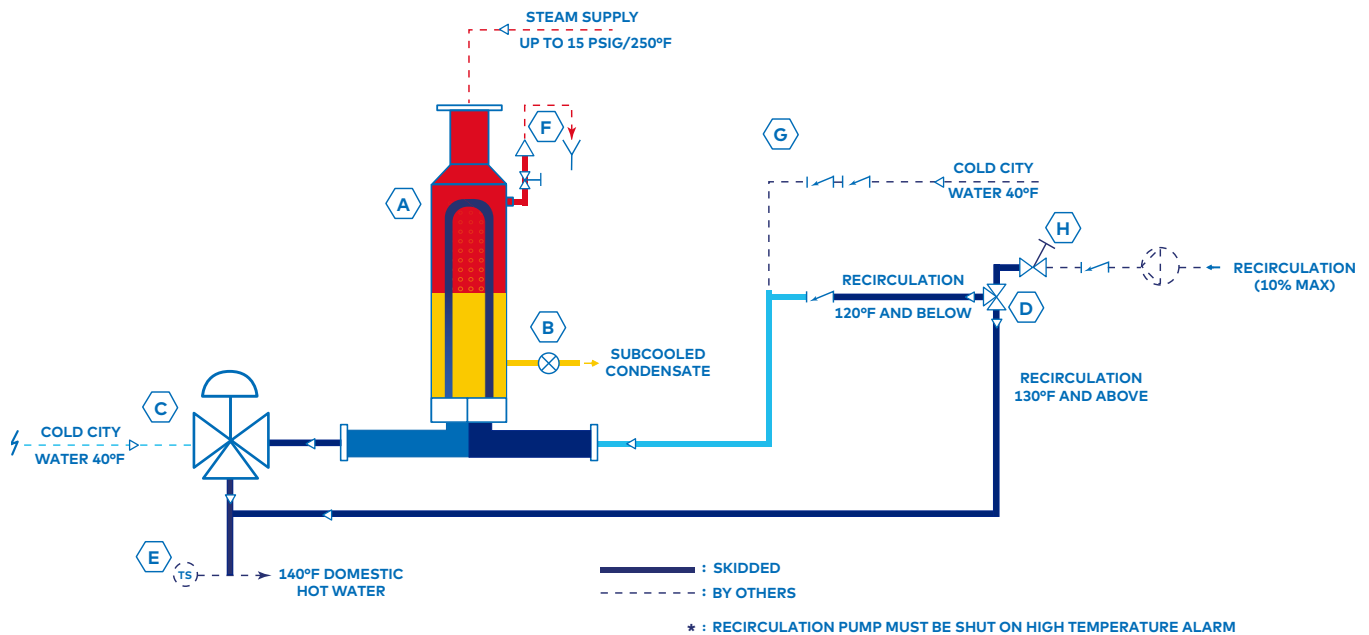
- Vertical flooded double-wall heat exchanger with subcooling condensate below 212°F, resulting in a 0% flash return system
